Skagit Land Trust co-founder Keith Wiggers will come to your home with his tractor and work for **3 hours** in your yard or garden.

The tractor has four main functions: Rototiller (4 ft wide, leaves the surface fine and smooth; cannot do rocky soils); loader with bucket and/or fork lift (move dirt, compost, poles, rocks, gravel, or spread dirt or gravel). 4 ft. "Brush Hog" rotary mower (good for clearing blackberries and tall grass and weeds). 5 ft. lawn mower (great for large areas).

#14: "Winter Cottonwoods" by Dederick Ward



#21: Eddyline Kayak - Samba




